Why should you become a partner with SRBP?

Everyone lives in a watershed.

A watershed is the land that water flows across or under on its way to a stream, river, or lake.

Rain and melting snow flows down or runs off hills and ridges to the lowest point in a watershed, or it seeps into the soil and travels as groundwater. As the water travels across farm fields, forests, prairies, suburban lawns, construction areas, city streets and parking lots, it picks up tiny particles of sand, soil, salt, oil, manure, fertilizers, pesticides and other pollutants along the way.

The quality of water and other natural resources within a watershed is a reflection of our daily activities. We all influence what happens in our watersheds and our watershed community (birds, fish, animals too), good or bad, by how we treat the natural resources.

What happens here affects areas downstream. All waters within the Sheboygan River Basin eventually flow into Lake Michigan impacting an even larger community.

There are many things YOU can do to keep your watershed community healthy and productive. Join SRBP to learn how YOU can have an impact on your local natural resources.
