# Site History

- Operated from 1872 to 1929.
- Consisted of three gas holders, one gas oil tank, three tar tanks, one purifier and several buildings associated with producing coal gas.
- The site was dismantled between 1950 and 1966.

---

# Activities Completed

- Investigation and cleanup of upland portion of the site including:
  - Soil removal and treatment
  - Installation of containment wall and cap
  - Operation and maintenance of a biosparge system
  - Continued groundwater monitoring program

---

# Activities Completed

- Investigation and cleanup activities were performed with WDNR supervision
  - Agreement between the City of Sheboygan, WDNR and WPSC
  - Work followed an USEPA-like process
  - Record of Decision issued by the State
  - USEPA kept informed throughout

---

# Activities to be Completed With USEPA

- Transfer oversight to USEPA – spring 2007
  - Upland operable unit
  - River operable unit
  - Focus on sediments
- Preparation of work plans
- Investigation of river sediments near former plant
  - Gas plant related contamination
  - Other “unrelated” contamination
- Documentation of findings/public participation
- Determine remedy

# Anticipated Schedule

- Receive Agency comments – Summer/Fall 2007:
  - Upland Operable Unit – review of prior work
  - River Operable Unit
- Prepare work plan - Fall 2007
- Conduct investigation - 2008
- Public review/USEPA ROD - 2009
